Plan to Support Safe Needle Collection and Disposal
for Saizen[®] (somatropin (rDNA origin) for injection)

EMD Serono is committed to meeting the needs of patients and the communities in which they live in. As part of this, we have developed a plan to support the safe collection and disposal of waste devices in support of Minnesota SF 1323 for the residents of Minnesota.

I. Providing for Effective Safe Needle Collection and Disposal

EMD Serono is working with a third-party organization to support the safe collection and disposal of waste devices. As part of this program, EMD Serono offers Minnesota residents who are using Saizen[®] (***somatropin (rDNA origin) for injection***) patients, the opportunity to participate in a free, Sharps container mail back program. The following items will be sent to MN residents on Saizen[®] therapy upon request:

- Introduction kit inclusive of 2 Sharps containers including mail back packaging.
- Replacement containers with mail-back packaging after the resident has mailed-back previously-supplied collection containers

Enrollment into this program is available for residents of MN using Saizen[®] and can be requested by calling Connections for Growth at 800-582-7989. Containers may be subject to availability.

II. Educating Patients

EMD Serono will place information about the sharps disposal ban in Minnesota on our company Web site in order to educate patients and the greater community. We will also proactively reach out to patient and professional organizations in the state of Minnesota to make them aware of EMD Serono's plan to support the safe collection and disposal of waste devices.
